See the "Reversing Falls" where exceptionally high tides of the Fundy cause the falls of the St. John River to go in reverse. Besides the usual city tours, Carnival has optional tours to charming St. Andrews on the Bay and the Bay of Fundy National Park. St. John also has a wonderful city market. (B,L,D)
