DAY 12: Cartagena. Home of the finest emeralds in the world, this Colombian city is filled with history and charm. Get an overview of the city and

harbor from the heights of La Popa Monastery. Other sites are the artisan center of Las Bovedas (*The Dungeons*), Plaza Bolivar, Palace of Inquisition and Church of San Pedro Claver. (B,L,D)
