Vermont Fall Foliage

Is there anything better than Vermont in autumn? Tree leaves boast vibrant oranges, reds, and yellows blended with green fir and pine trees. And, for you leaf peepers with cameras, there are beautiful photo ops just about everywhere you look! You'll savor the best of Vermont featuring delicious ice cream, maple flavored candy and crisp Vermont cheeses. Get on board now as space is limited!

DAY 1: Welcome to Vermont. Arrive Burlington airport and meet your Vermont Fall Foliage coach. Travel to the Golden Eagle Resort for a "Welcome Dinner" and four autumn colored nights. (D)

Next, visit the Dakin Farm, Vermont's tastiest attraction! Here you will see production of their gourmet meats and sample many of their fine products. Later, continue to the Shelburne Museum where you will have time to explore 45 acres of Americana including the side wheel steamship Ticonderoga. Dinner once more at the Golden Eagle Resort. (B,D)

DAY 4: Ben & Jerry's Ice Cream! Your first stop today is the Cold Hollow Cider Mill. See how they make this delicious cider and sample some of their products. Next comes more sampling at the Cabot Cheese and Lake Champlain Chocolate Annex. Yum! Then, visit the village of Stowe, where you'll have some free time to explore.
