The theatre dates from the 1st century BC and was once considered the finest in Spain. (B, L, D)

DAY 7: Funchal, Madeira. The island of Madeira is located in the Atlantic Ocean off the coast of Morocco. For over 100 years tourists have enjoyed its rugged volcanic peaks, beautiful tropical coastline and a climate that's never too hot or cold. Madeira lace and Madeira wine are both still produced here in the Old World tradition. (B, L, D)

DAY 8: Tenerife, Canary Isles. Largest of the Canary Archipelago, this island consists of many different regions - each with its own characteristics. Don't miss its mysterious pyramids. Enjoy a panoramic city tour of Santa Cruz and visit Pyramid Park, an area discovered by the world-famous adventurer Thor Heyerdahl. No one knows where the pyramids came from, but no one who sees them can forget these strange formations. (B, L, D)

DAYS 9-14: Crossing the Atlantic Ocean. Now, it's time to enjoy your floating resort. Most folks are awed by Royal
