DAY 4: Cozumel. Welcome to paradise! Most of what you've heard about this large island off the east coast of Mexico is true! It's a scuba diver's dream with clear water, natural and man-made reefs and a bounty of beautifully colored fish! There's even a program that lets you get up-close
