



# Itinerary

**Awesome! Inspiring! Magnificent! America's National Parks!** Located inside them are areas of untamed natural beauty and protected treasures. Escape summer's heat and humidity with a breathtaking journey to **Yellowstone & Glacier National Parks.**

**DAY 1: Salt Lake City.** Meet your Rockport Tours' coach and head for the western frontier! Shake the trail dust with a "Welcome Dinner" at **Butch Cassidy's**, and turn down the sheets at the **Super 8** in Montpelier, ID. (D)

**Day 2: Jackson Hole, WY.** The unbridled western town of Jackson is a short ride away. Stroll it's historic square, have lunch at the Cadillac Grille or take a stagecoach ride. Tonight, you'll ride a **Bar-T-5** covered wagon to Cache Creek Canyon for good chuckwagon grub and musical shenanigans. Overnight **Painted Buffalo** in Jackson, WY. (B,D)

**DAYS 3-4: Old Faithful awaits!** This morning marvel at mighty **Grand Teton**. Its peak is 13,771-ft. Visit the Visitor's Center, Chapel of the Transfiguration and beautiful Jenny Lake.

Later, the John D. Rockefeller Parkway takes you to **Yellowstone National Park** (7,300-ft elevation). America's first national park is considered the finest. Founded in 1872, this vast park features over 10,000 hot springs and the greatest concentration of geothermal features in the world. See the world's most photographed geyser-**Old Faithful** which erupts up to 20 times a day, reaching heights averaging 130-ft. You'll also visit the Fountain Paint Pots and majestic Hayden Valley. Watch for elk, bears, moose, bighorn sheep and one of the last herds of buffalo. Enjoy two nights at **Yellowstone Lake Cabins** inside the park. (B)

**DAYS 5-6: Centennial Park!** Your journey continues to northern Montana and **Glacier National Park**. The Crown Jewel of the National Parks System marks its 100th birthday on May 11th. Along with sister park, Waterton Lakes National Park in Canada, Glacier National Park is recognized as a World Heritage Site, a Biosphere Reserve, and was established as the world's first International Peace Park. Glacier National Park covers one million acres and contains 26 glaciers and over 762 lakes. We saw bears last year!

Board a restored 1930's "**Red Jammers**" bus for a guided tour on the "**Going-to-the-Sun Road**", a stunning 52-mile scenic byway. The road crosses the Continental Divide at Logan Pass and passes by the Weeping Wall. Enjoy two nights at **Many Glaciers Lodge**. (B)

**DAY 7: Billings, MT.** A scenic travel day with some photo stops. Overnight at the **Country Inn & Suites** in Billings, MT. (B)

**DAY 8: Deadwood, SD.** Your travels take you to the famous **Little Big Horn Battlefield** (formerly **Custer Battlefield**). Retrace the paths of George Armstrong Custer, his 7th Cavalry, and Sitting Bull at this fascinating monument- site of "Custer's Last Stand" in 1876. Down the road is **Devil's Tower Monument**, an 865-ft. granite

Deadwood is famous for Wild Bill Hickok, Calamity Jane, Poker Alice & Boot Hill! (B)

**DAY 9: Mount Rushmore.** This morning it's all aboard the **1880 Train** in Keystone. The narrow gauge line climbs steep grades in the shadow of the rocky summits of the Black Hills. Later, learn about Gutzen Borglum's 14-year dedication to carving **Mount**

**Rushmore.** See the granite sculptures of Jefferson, Lincoln, Roosevelt & Washington. (B)

**DAY 10: Alliance, NE.** Today, visit **Fort Robinson** where Crazy Horse was killed in 1877. And later witness a surreal photo opp. in Alliance, Nebraska You'll snooze well at the **Holiday Inn Select** in Cherry Creek, CO, after a satisfying "Farewell Dinner". (B,D)

**DAY 11: Making Money.** This morning you'll visit the **Denver Mint**, the single largest coin producer in the world. Coins produced here bear the "D" mark. After lunch head to the Denver airport and your flight home. (B)
