YOUR ITINERARY

Aug. 23: Fly to Missoula, MT. Check in to the C'mon Inn in Missoula before heading out to dinner, (D)

Aug. 24, Bison Range, Big Fork and Glacier: Travel north through "Big Sky Country". Start your day with a visit to the National Bison Range. Afterwards enjoy a scenic drive along the shores of Flathead Lake on your way to the small lakeside town of Big Fork. Big Fork is home to wonderful art galleries and restaurants, you will have time to explore and have lunch on your own.
