**Aug 21: Vancouver.** Fly to Vancouver and meet your group leader.

**Aug 22: Radiance of the Seas.** Today you will board the Radiance to begin your journey!

**Aug 23: Inside Passage:** Begin with a day at sea. Enjoy the inside passage as mountains and trees pass the ship on either side!

**Aug 24: Juneau.** Once you arrive you'll find majestic views and rich culture in every corner. With its snowcapped mountains, misty rainforests, massive glaciers and bounty of wildlife, Alaska's remote state capital is the perfect place to dive into nature.

**Aug 25: Icy Strait Point:** Icy Strait Point is one tiny port that's big on Alaskan wilderness and Native culture. Opened a decade ago by the Huna Tlingit Native Alaskans, it's easily one of the best spots in the region for fishing and whale watching. Dive into Native Alaska culture at a tribal dance show or pay a visit to Hoonah, Alaska's largest Tlingit village.

**Aug 26: Sitka.** A captivating blend of

Russian, Tlingit, and American history. Snow-capped peaks, Mount Edgecumbe's majesty, and abundant wildlife await. Kayak with sea otters, fish for giant halibut, and explore Baranof Island. Discover endless adventure under the midnight sun.

**Aug 27: Skagway:** The tiny town of Skagway still looks like it did during the Klondike Gold Rush over 100 years ago— and today it remains an outpost for thrilling Alaskan adventure. An old-time street car ride along bustling Broadway Street reveals well-preserved buildings, including the state's oldest hotel. You can see engraved walrus tusks at the Corrington Museum, or get lost in riveting historical reenactments around town.

**Aug 28: Hubbard Glacier:** Hubbard Glacier is 76 miles long, 7 miles wide, and 350 feet above the waterline where it meets the bay. Watch as massive chunks of ice crash into the bay, a process known as calving that the Tlingit people call "White Thunder."

**Aug 29: Seward:** Enjoy a scenic drive in your deluxe motor coach to the Alaska Wildlife Conservation Center to visit the animals under expert care. Enjoy a stroll and lunch on your own during the stop in downtown Anchorage before traveling further into the interior. From 4:30 p.m., your time in Talkeetna is your own. A stroll down the historic main street reveals this funky

town's singular mix of lively brew pubs, roadhouse restaurants, welcoming cafes and unique local shops. Overnight at the Talkeetna Alaskan Lodge.

**Aug 30: Alyeska:** Travel the coastal road along the Turnagain Arm and Cook Inlet into Anchorage, where you can get a taste of the big city and have lunch. Then sit back and relax on the journey into the wilds of Alaska. From 4:00 p.m., Talkeetna is yours to enjoy.

**Aug. 31: Denali/Talkeetna.** It's an early drive to Denali National Park, where your adventure begins with the Denali Natural History Tour, traveling into the park's unspoiled wilderness on the lookout for the moose, caribou, bears and other wildlife.

**Sep. 1: Denali/Anchorage.** There is time to enjoy the scenery around the lodge — walking the trails, or relaxing with a view of the river — before boarding the glass-domed cars of Wilderness Express train for the train ride to Anchorage. From 8:30 p.m., Anchorage is yours to discover.

**Sep. 2: Anchorage.** Your Adventure Specialist will ensure you transfer to the airport on time.
