Experience the vibrant colors of fall as you journey through stunning landscapes on scenic train rides along the East Coast!

Oct. 4: Fly to Newark, NJ and check into the Double Tree by Hilton. Tonight you will enjoy a welcome dinner with wine and sangria!

Oct. 5: Board the Amtrak in Newark for a scenic ride to Boston, taking in the vibrant fall colors along the way. Upon arrival, check into your Boston hotel and enjoy a relaxing dinner to end the day.

Oct. 6: This morning, hop aboard the AMTRAK DOWNEASTER to Maine! Enjoy free time and lunch in the picturesque Dock Square of Kennebunkport. Afterward, meet

your local guide for an exciting afternoon tour of the coastal villages of Kennebunk and Kennebunkport. You'll pass by sandy beaches, rugged coastline, and the iconic George Bush estate at Walker's Point. Oct. 9: Start your day with breakfast before departing for Vermont. Explore the Vermont Country Store in Weston, a charming spot filled with unique finds. Then, head to Bennington for a delicious lunch at the Publyk House. Afterward, travel to the Clark Art Institute in the Berkshires, where you can enjoy a self-guided tour of its impressive collection, including works by Renoir, Remington, and Homer. The museum is surrounded by 130 acres of scenic beauty. End the day with dinner at a local restaurant before checking into your hotel.

Oct. 10: After Breakfast, visit the Norman Rockwell Museum. See many of the illustrator's works in the original oil paintings. Later travel to the airport for your return home!
